What should I do after treatment with YCANTH™?

After treatment, follow your healthcare provider's instructions. You can return to your usual bathing routine **after** 24 hours or as otherwise recommended by your healthcare provider.



Wash all treatment sites 24 hours after treatment with a gentle soap and water. Avoid washcloths or abrasive surfaces. You may wash YCANTH off of your skin sooner if severe blistering or pain or other severe reactions occur.



Avoid creams, lotions, oils, or sunscreen on the treated skin. These products should not be applied for 24 hours or until after washing the affected and treated skin



If discomfort occurs, over-the-counter medicine such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen can be taken as needed. You may wash YCANTH off your skin sooner if you experience severe blistering, severe pain, or other adverse reactions. You should also contact your healthcare provider immediately or call 1-877-VERRICA.
